Basic Data with full API

(if you use the entity module)

- Abstraction

Bundles

- Collection of fields

Fields

- **Structured data** (WYSIWYG Editor is not...)

Node Types

- Easy
- Semantically clean
- Bloated...

Taxonomy

- Trees
- Tags
- Decoration

Entity Reference

- Connect everything with anything

Sub-Reference Model

- A base bundle with only the common fields
- Different modules that provide children for specialization
- Useful for multisites

Fieldcollections / Paragraphs

- Sub-Reference out of the box
- Field UI
- Multi Instances
- View Modes (Please make a patch)

- Context
- Panes
- Inheritance

Panelizer

- Panelized entities
- Combine with Field collections
- Landingpages
